

Adding Virtual Tours

The Unipol site can now support links to externally hosted content for displaying walkthroughs and videos related to your properties.

To add a link log into your dashboard and open the required property record in **My Properties**.

Click on the **Amenities & Facilities** tab and paste the URL into the **Virtual Tour URL** box then click **Save**.

Walkthrough

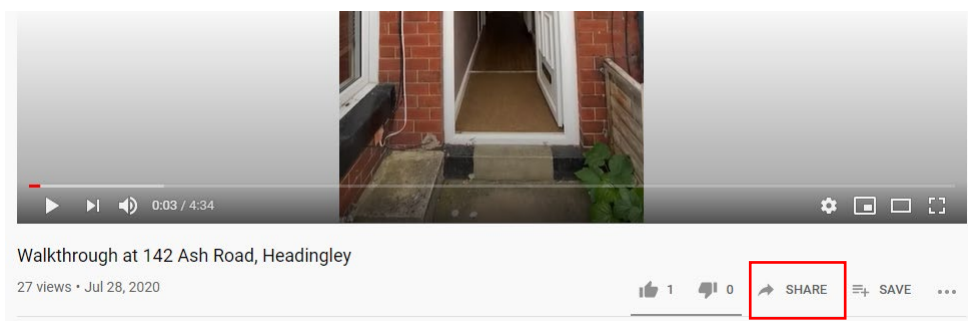
Walkthroughs allow students to control movement around a property and give a 360-degree view. These can be hosted on any website and usually have a URL similar to the following:

<https://www.mysite/walkthrough/property1>

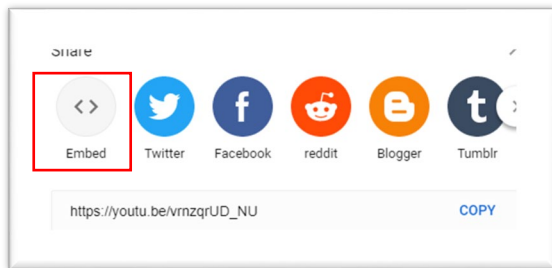
YouTube Videos

Videos hosted on YouTube need a specific link obtaining to allow them to work

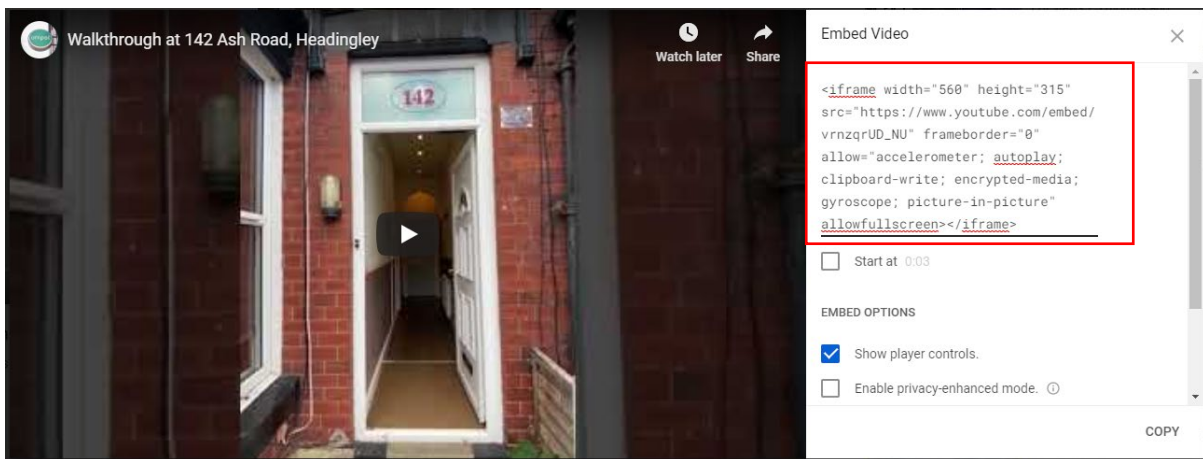
Click on the **SHARE** option under the video you want to embed



Then click the **Embed** option in the popup



You then need to take the just the URL from all the code presented
